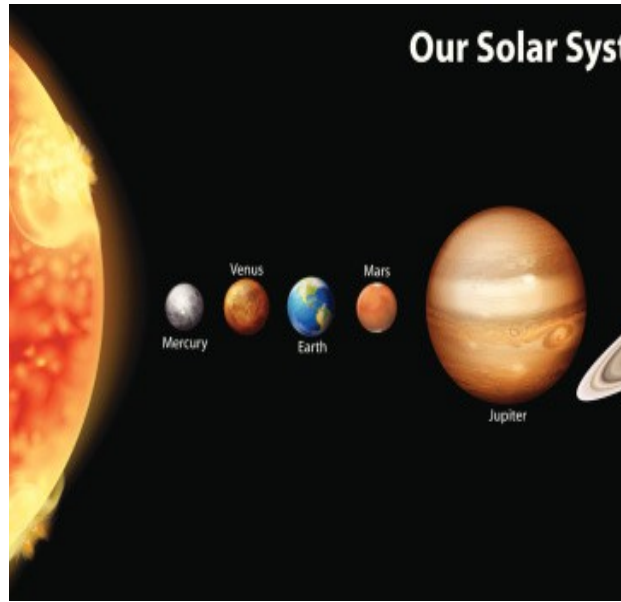


SPACE
