Dear Parents/carers,

Welcome back to the summer term; let's hope for some lovely weather this year.

Attached is this term's grid of topic homework options related to our 'Bristol' topic. Once again we would like the children to complete three tasks. The deadline for completion of all tasks is Friday 6th July. We will not be holding an open afternoon this term due to our commitments with our production, but we will be displaying the children's work in class, if you would like to view it at any point in the second half term. We plan to visit Bristol and the SS Great Britain on Tuesday 1st May as part of our topic, a letter about this visit will be sent shortly.

As before, we will continue to send home regular homework. This will be issued on Fridays for completion by the following Wednesday. There may be occasional weeks when we do not send home this additional work.

Please continue to listen to your child read at home on a regular basis. Ten minutes daily makes a significant difference to your child. The Rainbow Reading bookmark scheme will continue and we hope that children will have achieved their 70 reads to an adult since its launch by the end of the year. Reading diaries and books should be in school every day.

PE kit (indoor and outdoor) should also be kept in school and with the warmer weather hopefully arriving, a named water bottle is essential for the children to have easy access to water during lessons in class and to take outside during PE lessons. Owl class will be swimming on a Monday morning this term so should have their swimming kits with them.

The annual end of year show, 'The Lion King' produced by KS2 will be held during the first week of July. Evening performances will be held at 6.30pm on Wednesday 4th and Thursday 5th July with a matinee performance on Monday 2nd July at 2.15pm. Further details of tickets will follow during the term.
