YEAR 4 - KILVE COURT RESIDENTIAL CENTRE
24th – 26th April 2024

We are pleased to inform you about our Year 4 residential trip which will take place at Kilve Court Residential Centre near Bridgwater from Wednesday 24th to Friday 26th April 2024.

Kilve Court is a site run by SSE Outdoors, a company that runs children's adventure activity holidays. We have been attending Kilve Court Residential Centre for a number of years and are very happy with the service they provide. The activity centre is run by appropriately qualified and trained staff and a number of Wedmore staff will also be attending the trip. The aims of the trip are both educational and fun, they are intended to give your child the opportunity to develop independence, to interact closely with their peers and engage in a range of challenging activities led by qualified instructors and supported by Wedmore staff.

During the course of the stay the children will participate in a range of activities, including archery, low ropes course, abseil tower, team building, Quantock walk with shelter building as well as evening-led activities.

The cost of the trip is £202.77 and covers the cost of accommodation, all meals, activities and coach travel. Payment can be made in 3 instalments of £67.59 payable by the 16th February, 15th March and 12th April 2024. This will be found on Parentpay.

We do recognise that this is a significant amount of money, if you have any financial concerns regarding the cost of the trip and you are unable to pay the total amount or, wish to pay in smaller instalments over a longer period of time, then please speak to a member of the Wedmore office team.

Please note, that it is school policy to support payment or make payment in full, for families whose circumstances qualify and that the school receives Pupil Premium Funding for their child. If you would like information on how families qualify for Pupil Premium Funding, please speak to a member of the Wedmore office team.

Miss Kent will be holding an information session for parents/carers on Monday 22nd January at 5.00 pm, where you will be shown a presentation about Kilve Court Residential Centre and you will have the opportunity to ask any questions you may have.
