#### This Week ...

#### **Duck Class:**

This week our story has been the hungry caterpillar and a very popular activity was to use the pipettes to drop different colour onto the cotton pads, we talked about the colour mixing that we could see happening. We have welcomed our 5 little caterpillars and will look after them until they turn into butterflies, watch this space! It has been wonderful to spend so much time outside, long may this weather continue!



#### **Robin Class:**


With the warm weather arriving Robin Class have been busy learning about how we can stay safe in the sun. The children are doing an amazing job with their phase 4 common exception words and learning longer words to read. We are continuing our story of the Rainbow Fish and focussing on specific vocabulary that appears in the story for example glide and sparkling. We have been becoming experts in using our numbers to 10 and representing them using two numbers to make the whole. Finally we have observed how our bean plants are growing, looking carefully at the roots, and are very excited that some of our beans now have stems and leaves too!

Finally a huge thank you to the PTA who have helped us resource some outdoor equipment which will help us develop our physical and personal, social and emotional skills linking to the EYFS curriculum.



#### **Deer Class:**

Deer class have had a lovely week! In Art, we finished our Paul Klee inspired castle collages this week. We used a range of colours, materials and shapes to fill the shape of a castle. In Maths this week we have been busy learning about measuring using cm's. We began measuring using dienes cubes which are 1cm, before having a go at using a 30cm ruler to measure items in the classroom. We discussed how rulers are a useful tool to measure small objects but figured it wouldn't be useful to use 30 cm rulers to measure the school!!



#### **Rabbit Class:**

Rabbit Class have packed this four day week full of excitement! In science we've been learning about plants and carried out an investigation about the conditions needed for plants to grow well. We looked at bulbs and seeds closely, split them in half and learnt about the different parts and how they grow. We then went on to plant our own beans. In English we are learning all about instruction writing. We then followed a set of instructions to make a tasty sandwich. Spreading the butter proved to be a little tricky for some. In art we are still learning about the works of Mondrian. The children used masking tape and primary colours to create their own master pieces. This week in Maths we are learning about different fractions of shapes, lengths and a number of objects.



#### **Fox Class:**

The sun has finally come out for Fox class this week!! We have had a fantastic week of learning. In English we have begun a new unit on instruction writing. The children were able to use the new model text to make their own healthy sandwich, they were really excited about this and they did an amazing job. In maths we have also started to look at fractions, and the children have been able to identify one half and one quarter. We have also been getting creative in art by exploring some of Mondrian's artwork. The children were able to create their own pieces inspired by his cubism art, they did really well!



#### **Owl Class:**

This week in Owl class we have had a lovely week! We have continued to write our newspapers about the classroom disaster and they are looking so good. However, I seem to be getting the blame! On Thursday, we took our maths lesson out in the sun and continued with our fraction work. We have also started our class mural and it is looking incredible and Owls worked fantastic in their groups
