**YEAR 4 –Bristol Aquarium trip**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Owl class will be going to **Bristol Aquarium on Thursday, 28th November 2024**. This trip will offer a fantastic opportunity for children to explore marine life and gain a deeper understanding of the world's oceans and aquatic environments. This links closely with our current enquiry topic and will be a great opportunity for the children to explore their learning further. We will be leaving school at approximately 9:30am and be returning around 3:00pm. Children will need to wear **school uniform, bring a packed lunch and a water bottle**.

The highlight of the visit will be the **“Save Our Seas” guided tour**, which encourages children to connect with the natural world by observing aquatic creatures up close. During this tour, the children will learn about human impacts on various marine environments such as **mangrove forests, rainforests, and the open ocean**. They will also discover the important conservation efforts being carried out to protect these habitats and the species that live in them.

As part of the tour, children will have the chance to participate in an **exclusive fish feeding experience** and engage in an exciting workshop titled **“Coral Reefs and Climate Change”**, where they will explore the challenges facing coral reefs and what can be done to protect these vital ecosystems.

The cost of the trip includes admission to the aquarium, travel by coach, participation in the guided tour and workshop, and the fish feeding experience. We kindly ask that payment of **£19.12** be made by **15<sup>th</sup> November** through parent pay (consent is included in ParentPay).

**Unfortunately, if we do not cover the cost the trip we may not be able to go ahead.** If your child is Pupil Premium or you have difficulty with payment please speak to us.
