Dear Parents/Carers,

Following on from my letter last term about wrap around care, I would like to provide further details of what we have planned.

Breakfast club will run daily after February half term (the first day back will be 24th February) and times will remain the same (8:00 til 8:40). Sessions will continue to run in the hall, we will be offering breakfast as part of this. Duck class children will be included in breakfast club provision, the duck class team will be with the children to provide continuity and familiarity.

After school club will also run in the hall from Monday to Thursdays, again the times will remain the same (3:25 til 5:30) and snacks will be provided. We have decided that Duck class children will not be included in our after school provision, the duck class team will continue to offer this as it is now. Louise Palmer will be staying on to help run the breakfast and after school sessions, this will help provide continuity for the children. Further details including costs will follow, our aim is to ensure wrap around care continues to provide our children with a welcoming, safe and happy experience.

Since we have no capacity at this time to provide a holiday club ourselves, I have spoken to Jack Masters about providing one for February half term initially. Sports Masters will be offering sessions which include sports as well as arts and crafts activities for up to 32 children from ages 5 to 11 years old. Children in Robin class can access a morning or afternoon session (4 hours) for a reduced rate, please see information attached.

Hopefully this will help some working parents in the short term, going forwards I will be looking into permanent plans for full wrap around care. As always, I value your input and feedback to help shape our provision and make it the best it can be.
