Duck Class

A very wet start to the new term but we all really enjoyed splashing in the puddles and standing under the rain! We have started our new inquiry called Seashells and sunshine by looking at photos of our family trips to the beach, joining in with lots of seaside role play and exploring shells and sea creatures. Some nursery children also really enjoyed their first session in the pool on Tuesday and were very excited to tell the rest of the class all about it.



Robin Class

Robin class have all loved their first swimming lesson as a class! They got changed in record timing and were all very brave and enjoyed being in the water, even the less confident children got into the water. We are very proud! Robin class also enjoyed learning about hen chicks and got to meet some - very cute!

Deer Class

Deer Class have had a very exciting week! We enjoyed our first swimming session in the school pool, which was a fantastic experience for everyone. We have also begun our new enquiry learning topic about castles, knights and dragons. The children shared what they already know about the enquiry and asked lots of thoughtful questions about what they would like to find out over the coming weeks.

Rabbit Class

This week, Rabbit Class enjoyed two exciting new experiences! The children took part in their very first recorder lesson in music, where they learned how to hold the instrument correctly and played their first notes. They also had their first swimming lesson in Wedmore pool with the Kings coaches. The children showed great enthusiasm, listened carefully to instructions and demonstrated excellent behaviour throughout both activities. We are looking forward to seeing their confidence and skills continue to grow over the coming weeks.

Squirrel Class

What a lovely first week back we've had in Squirrels! We have started our final Year 3 topic, Ancient Egypt, and the children are already proving to be knowledgeable, curious and eager to learn more. We have begun exploring the importance of the River Nile and its impact on Ancient Egyptian life. In English, we are enjoying *Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx* and have had lots of fun writing our own riddles. In Maths, we have started learning about fractions, which the children are finding both challenging and enjoyable. We are also putting the finishing touches to our DT drawstring bags, and we are incredibly proud of the fantastic effort the children have put into them!

Owl Class

Extreme Earth

In Geography, we explored where the world's mountains, volcanoes and earthquake belts are located. The children used their atlas skills to identify and map these features, looking carefully for patterns and making connections between their locations. We also discovered how mountains are formed and learned about the powerful forces that shape our planet. In Art, we began studying *The Great Wave off Kanagawa* by the Japanese artist Katsushika Hokusai. Inspired by Hokusai's famous nature prints, the children created their own sketches, experimenting with line, shape and movement to capture the beauty and power of nature.

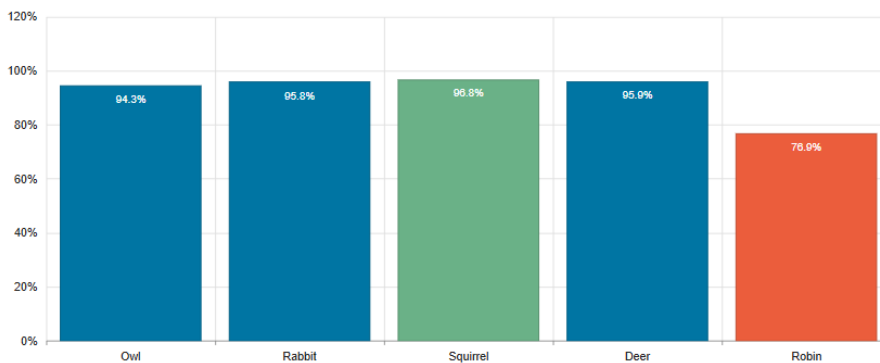
