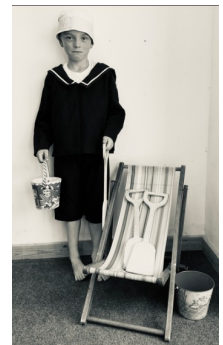


Deer Class
