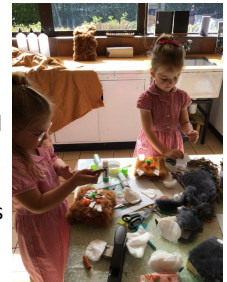
Duck Class

This week duck class have been thinking about wildlife and how they adapt to the changing season. They used clay to make spiky hedgehogs and have enjoyed reading stories and non fiction books about them.



Robin Class

This week Robins have been on the exciting adventures of The Gruffalo Granny and Squiggles on the loose. We have been creating our own Gruffalo characters using a range of materials, and using our letters sounds to mark make and write our letters as secret codes. In our maths we have been counting objects 1:1 and met our counting friend Zoe Zebra who needed lots of help with her numbers, Robins were great at finding how many of something we had altogether.



Deer Class

We have had another busy week of learning in Deer Class! In Geography, we have done some excellent work using aerial photographs and maps to identify different places around our school. In Maths, we have enjoyed lots of practical learning, using objects to compare amounts and learning how to use the <, > and = symbols. Well done!



Rabbit Class

Rabbit Class have had another busy week! In our enquiry lessons, the children have been learning all about **Scotland**, exploring its capital city and identifying a range of **human and physical features**. In English, the children have been investigating the different features of an **instruction text** and have worked hard to create their own plans. They are now ready to use these plans to write their own clear and organised sets of instructions!

Squirrel Class

Squirrels have had a fantastic week of learning! In English, we have been using expanded noun phrases to create vivid descriptions of Stone Age cave paintings, including *"huge, lumbering bison charging in their herds."* In Geography, we used maps to decide where we would settle in Wedmore if we were Stone Age people, thinking carefully about the resources we would need. In Science, we investigated how permeable different rocks are and explored how we could group them. We have had great fun learning and exploring together this week!

Owl Class

Another excellent week in Owls! We have continued exploring *The Lost Thing* in English, developing our character descriptions, comparing characters and sharpening our inference skills.

In Maths, we've been revisiting numbers to 1,000 and building confidence working with three- and four-digit numbers. Our Times Tables focus this week has been **doubling**, and the children have been doing brilliantly with their recall. In our Oceans enquiry, we've also been learning about the **water cycle** and how water moves around our planet. Another busy week of learning!
